BOLD ANNOUNCEMENTS MADE BY PM MODI DURING HIS INDEPENDENCE DAY ADDRESS

On the 79th Independence Day of India (15 August 2025), during his address from the Red Fort, New Delhi, Prime Minister Narendra Modi made a series of announcements that signal a nation ready to leap into the future. From making India's first semiconductor chip to building jet engines, from tenfold nuclear expansion to a US\$ 120 billion youth employment push, his message was unambiguous: India will define its own destiny, set its own terms, and aim to become a developed nation by 2047.



Key Announcements from PM Modi's Address included:


- Semiconductors: By the end of this year, the nation will roll out its first Made in India chip.
- Nuclear Energy: Capacity to Grow Tenfold by 2047
- Goods and Services Tax Reforms: Providing relief to MSMEs, local vendors, and consumers.
- Reform Task Force: Next-generation reforms for the demands of a \$10 trillion economy by 2047.
- US\$ 120 billion major employment scheme: To benefit 30 million young Indians
- High-Powered Demography Mission: Ensuring the unity, integrity, and rights of citizens.
- Energy Independence: National Deepwater Exploration Mission to tap ocean resources, alongside major expansions in solar, hydrogen, hydro and nuclear power.
- Made in India Jet Engines

INDIA'S TRADE POLICIES: HOW THE COUNTRY IS POSITIONING ITSELF FOR GLOBAL INVESTMENT

Invest India shared an article detailing India's accelerating rise as a global trade and manufacturing hub through reforms, targeting \$2 trillion in exports by 2030. The 2025 Union Budget, record FDI inflows, new Free Trade Agreements and the National Manufacturing Mission are boosting high-tech and labour-intensive sectors, streamlining tariffs, and enhancing ease of doing business. These measures aim to position India as a reliable global exporter, generate millions of jobs, and drive its goal of becoming a \$5 trillion economy by 2029.


BHARAT STEEL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE


INDIA ACHIEVES MILESTONE OF 100 GW SOLAR PV MODULE MANUFACTURING CAPACITY

India has achieved the milestone of 100 GW Solar PV Module Manufacturing Capacity under the Approved List of Models and Manufacturers (ALMM), a remarkable rise from just 2.3 GW in 2014. With initiatives like the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for High-Efficiency Solar Modules, India is building a robust, self-reliant solar manufacturing ecosystem. This achievement strengthens the path towards the target of 500 GW non-fossil capacity by 2030.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

CABINET CLEARS FOUR SEMICONDUCTOR MANUFACTURING UNITS WITH AN OUTLAY OF US\$ 550 MILLION

India's Union Cabinet, approved four semiconductor manufacturing projects under the India Semiconductor Mission (ISM), with an outlay of US\$ 550 million marking a significant boost to the country's semiconductor ecosystem. With six projects already underway, the four new approvals bring the total to ten semiconductor initiatives with cumulative investments of approximately US\$ 19.2 billion across six states.

NATION'S FIRST INDIGENOUS COMMERCIAL EARTH OBSERVATION SATELLITE CONSTELLATION



Indian National Space Promotion and Authorization Centre (IN-SPACe) announced the selection of PixxelSpace India-led Consortium to Establish Nation's First Indigenous Commercial Earth Observation Satellite Constellation. This initiative represents a pivotal point for India's space sector. For the first time in the history of the Indian space sector, a private consortium would invest more than Rs. 1,200 crore (~ US\$ 140 million) over the next 5 years to launch a constellation of 12 state-of-the-art Earth Observation Satellites.







Halide Edib Adıvar, one of Turkey's most prominent early 20th-century writers and political figures, shared a remarkable connection with India. In the 1930s, she visited India at the invitation of leaders in the independence movement. During her time in India, Halide Edib not only addressed political issues but also engaged deeply with Indian intellectuals, reformers, and students. She admired India's cultural richness and was particularly interested in its educational reforms and nationalist literature.

Halide Edib's visit to India inspired her travel memoir Inside India (published in 1937), which offered a vivid, first-hand account of her journeys through Bombay, Delhi, Aligarh, Hyderabad, and other parts of the subcontinent. The book wove together her observations on India's social fabric, politics, religious diversity, and cultural richness, alongside reflections on her meetings with prominent Indian leaders of that time. It remains one of the most notable Turkish literary works on India, preserving the warmth and mutual respect between the two nations.


EMBASSY OF INDIA, ANKARA CELEBRATES 79TH INDEPENDENCE DAY OF INDIA
